PROFILE

I am a lexicographer, corpus linguist, and onomastician. For ten years (1990–2000) I was chief editor of current English Dictionaries at Oxford University Press. More recently, I have held research posts and taught linguistics and lexicology at undergraduate and postgraduate levels in Britain, America, and the Czech Republic. I am currently a visiting professor at two institutions: the Bristol Centre for Linguistics (University of the West of England, Bristol), and the Research Institute of Information and Language Processing (University of Wolverhampton). I am a frequent invited plenary speaker at international conferences on lexicography, corpus linguistics, figurative language, and related topics.

My main research interests are:

- **Corpus analysis of collocations and clause semantics in English**
This work has involved re-evaluating numerous basic assumptions in linguistics; I have found it necessary to develop a new, empirically well-founded theory of meaning in language (the Theory of Norms and Exploitations). The fundamental issues addressed by this theory are: 1) the relationship between word meaning and word use; 2) the role of collocations and valency in making meanings; 3) the nature of linguistic creativity. My book on this subject was published by MIT Press in January 2013.
- **Figurative language**
I am writing a book on *Similes and Comparisons* for publication by Oxford University Press. Related to this is a planned book on *Semantic Resonance*.
- **Surnames**
I am the editor-in-chief of the Dictionary of American Family Names and lead researcher on the AHRC-funded project, “Family Names of the UK” (2010–14; due for publication in 2016), exploring the linguistic and social origins, geographical distribution, and history of family names.
